Program Description:

This 14-hour videoconference broadcast will provide a review of selected topics which can help prepare experienced E.D. nurses for the Emergency Nursing Certification Exam. This course is intended for the E.D. nurse who already has a strong knowledge base of emergency nursing. Content will include emergencies involving the cardiovascular, pulmonary, GI, renal, metabolic, neurological, hematologic, EENT, and musculo-skeletal systems. Behavioral as well as OB/GYN emergencies will also be addressed. Sample test questions will be utilized throughout the course. This course does not guarantee that participants will pass the certification exam. Individual participants are highly encouraged to take the time to study and gain mastery of the topics.

4. Summarize the rationale behind all nursing interventions performed on patients who present with various types of physical and psychological emergencies.
5. Discuss the current accepted standards for the transfer and transport of emergency patients.
