Day One: Acute Coronary Syndrome, Valve Diseases, Hemodynamic Monitoring, Shock, Heart Failure, and Cardiomyopathy

Day Two: Coagulation physiology, DIC, Heparin-Induced Thrombocytopenia, Neutropenia, Acute Leukemia, AIDS, ARDS, Asthma, Pulmonary Embolus, Pneumonia, Ventilator Management

Day Three: Diabetes Mellitus, Diabetes Insipidus, SIADH, Thyroid Storm, Myxedema, DKA, HHNK, Acute Pancreatitis, Acute Liver Failure, Acute G.I. Bleeding, Acute Renal Failure, Electrolyte Imbalances, Stroke, Epidural Bleed, Subarachnoid Hemorrhage, Intracranial Hemorrhage, Intracranial Aneurysm, Multisystem Failure
